Options for future action were considered along with the need to progress discussions with the Cilybebyll Community Growers. RESOLVED that –

- Council engage with the Cilybebyll Community Growers and with individual allotment holders to fulfil its obligations as landowners
- Council's commitment to the project be re-affirmed, noting that a longer period of implementation is required
- Details of a phased approach be agreed with the Cilybebyll Community Growers
- Council continue working with its specialist consultants and in view of their specific expertise and the need for continuity, the contractor team associated with the consultants be engaged to progress the phased programme of work
- The Chairman and Clerk be authorised to request a quotation and instruct contractors to proceed on the basis of the budget previously agreed.

164 LON TANYRALLT PLAYGROUND ALLTWEN

The Clerk summarised his discussions with officers of NPT CBC regarding drainage issues at the Lon Tanyrallt Playground and indicated that a desk study yielding information to facilitate a scheme was the best that could be secured at this stage. He also outlined the current situation with regard to market rent, the offset grant available and concerns regarding non-domestic rates. RESOLVED that further progress await information in respect of these matters.

165 WELSH GOVERNMENT CONSULTATION ON REFORMING LOCAL GOVERNMENT

The neighbour has now drawn attention to the deterioration of the existing fence and requested, once again, that it be attended to. RESOLVED that the Clerk meet with the original contractor to agree the scope of works and a price and refer back to Council in due course.

187 COMMUNITY CENTRE MANAGEMENT

1. The Clerk advised Members of an approach from the South West Wales Woodturning Club who used one of the rooms at the Alltwen Community Centre on an exclusive basis. Due to an increase in membership, the Club requested consideration of a room swap at the Centre to provide additional space for their activities. Following discussion, Council RESOLVED not to agree with the room swap proposal, but to offer discussions on exploring dedicated use of a refurbished area of the Unders at the Centre.
2. The Clerk informed Members that he had instructed electrical contractors to undertake testing of electrical fittings and emergency lights at each of the two community centres. RESOLVED noted.

189 RHOS PARK ALLOTMENTS

Further to Minute 163 of Council on 07 March 2016, the Clerk reported on the positive engagement which had occurred with the Cilybebyll Community Growers and indicated that contractors had been appointed to undertake the first phase of specified works. He further reported that discussions regarding the next phase should take place in the early autumn. RESOLVED NOTED.

190 LON TANYRALLT PLAYGROUND ALLTWEN

Further to Minute 164 of Council on 07 March 2016, the Clerk reported on the outstanding matters requiring consideration. Whilst there was no further clarity on non-domestic rates liability and responses from other parties were still outstanding, the Clerk estimated that the likely cost would be low if there was a liability to pay non-domestic rates. He further advised Members that very limited information had been forwarded from NPT CBC with regard to the drainage issues and a potential solution, and that he did not expect any further clarification. He outlined options for Council to consider if it was minded to make progress, and Members advised that a petition calling for improvement of the County Borough owned facility was currently being circulated. It was RESOLVED that Council –

- focus on a smaller area that could be developed with limited impact from drainage issues
- commission an independent view as to how a reduced site could be drained to accommodate a redeveloped playground
- approach playground suppliers to establish whether they have sufficient expertise to design a scheme that takes current drainage issues into consideration
- receive a further report before responding to NPT CBC.
